

Child Transportation Agreement

Responsibilities of the Parent/Guardian: 1. Ensure that the child(ren) are ready and available for pick-up at the designated time and location. 2. Provide any necessary information about the child(ren), including medical conditions, allergies, or other relevant details that may impact transportation. 3. Notify the Provider in advance of any changes to the transportation schedule or arrangements.	Initial
Liability and Insurance: The Provider shall maintain appropriate liability insurance coverage for child transportation. However, the Parent/Guardian acknowledges that the Provider shall not be held liable for any unforeseen incidents or accidents that may occur during transportation. Termination of Agreement: Either Party may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to the other Party two(2) weeks in advance.	Initial
Governing Law: This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Texas, Harris County.	Initial
